

Additional Batters. Use when more than three batters hit in one batting lineup spot. Note the lineup spot number (1-9) in the 'Bats' box. Auxiliary boxes. Use when a plate appearance is voided, noting the voided PA number (e.g. '13a' if the voided PA would have been 14).

1B: Single. 2B: Double. 3B: Triple. HR: Home run. BB: Base on Balls (Walk). IBB: Intentional Base on Balls. HBP: Hit by Pitch. E: Error.

Note: # = insert the position number of the relevant fielder(s).\*

FC: Fielder's Choice.

for a called third strike). U#: Unassisted putout. P#: Pop out. L#: Line out. F#: Fly out. (Optional: put an 'f" in front of the P, L, or F if the out was recorded in foul territory) SF#: Sacrifice fly out. SacB: Sacrifice bunt. FO: Force Out. DP: Double Play TP: Triple Play. CS: Caught Stealing.

When more than one fielder is involved in the same play, chart the movement of the ball between the fielders using their fielding position numbers\*. For example:

#-#: Assist and putout (e.g. second baseman to first baseman = 4-3)

#-#-#: Assist, assist and putout (e.g. shortstop to the second baseman to the first baseman = 6-4-3).

#### Base advancement BK: Balk. SB: Stolen Base. WP: Wild Pitch.

PB: Passed Ball \* Refer to the diagram overleaf.



Runs. If a player scores a run, put a dot in the bottom left-hand corner of his box.



RBIs. Put one dot in the middle of the diamond for each RBI gained on the plate appearance.



Outs. When a player makes an out, record which out of the inning it was by writing the number (1,2 or 3) and circling it.



Pitching Lines - #: Uniform number. L/R: Left or right-handed. IN: Relevant scorebox number of the pitcher's first batter faced. O: (out) Relevant scorebox number of the pitcher's lirst batter faced. WLS: Indicate whether the pitcher was awarded with a Win, Loss or Save. BF: Batters faced (number of).IP: Innings Pitched. H: Hits allowed, R: Runs conceded. ER: Earned runs conceded. SO: Strike Outs. BB: Base on balls (Walks). HR: Home runs conceded.

#### **Proof Box** Auxiliary box Sums must be equal.



SAC: Sacrifice outs. PO: Put Outs. HBP: Hit by pitch. I/O: Interference/ Obstruction LOB: Left on Base.

### #: Uniform number

AB: At-bat. A player is not credited with an at-bat if: a) he reaches base via a walk or 'hit by pitch', b) if he 'sacrifices' nimself.

## BB: Base on Balls (Walk)

BI: (Runs) Batted In: A batter gets credited with one BI for each runner that scores as a esult of his plate appearance. This includes when a batter walks with the bases loaded and when a run scores on a sacrifice' out. A batter does not get a BI if he hits into a double play, or would have hit nto a double play had the person fielding at first base not committed an error. (More commonly referred to as an RBI).

## E: Error(s)

H: Hit. A player does not get credited with a hit if he reaches base on an error or as a result of a 'fielder's choice' (when a fielder chooses to put out another unner instead).


N: The relevant box number of the batter's first plate appearance.

OB: The number of runners eft on base at the end of an nning.

P: (Fielding) Position. This efers to the number or abbreviation as set out below.

R: Runs.

## Fielding positions



- 1: Pitcher.
- 2: Catcher.
- 3: First baseman.
- 4: Second baseman.
- 5: Third baseman.
- 6: Shortstop. 7: Left fielder.
- 8: Centre fielder.
- 9: Right fielder.

DH: Designated Hitter.

PH: Pinch Hitter. PR: Pinch Runner.
